Schools visit overview - what to expect



Before you arrive:

All our staff will have had their temperatures checked before you arrive and we will have sanitised all the interactives in the Museum.



When you arrive:

You will find we have a very large carpark, so you can be dropped off by our entrance and walk directly straight in to the Museum.

When you come into the Museum:

Our staff will greet you and ask you to sanitise your hands before you enter and direct you to follow our one way system into the Museum.



In the classroom:

Our classroom has been set up so that you are all facing to the front, with safe distancing between each desk. I will demonstrate from the front, wearing a face shield and all objects you use will have been quarantined for 72 hours prior to your visit.

In the Museum Galleries:

The Museum will have been booked out just for your visit so only your bubble will be allowed in; there are sanitisation points throughout, and the large galleries allow plenty of social distancing.
